• Mandatory Safety Training: Upon opening the link, follow the instructions to register. After you register, our Director of Safeties and Facilities will receive a notification and give you access (Allow 2 business days for this to be completed). Upon logging into your personal BGCA.net account, you will need to click on the "Spillett University" tab and then "Spillett Leadership University" for training. This will direct you to the Spillett University training platform. Once here, you will be given video training options. Please search in the search icon (located in the top right corner) for the training video titled, "Child Sexual Abuse Prevention" and watch the 45-minute video.


